





Thank you all for being here with us today as we embark on this new journey, a journey that signifies the warm relations between Uganda and China and demonstrates Uganda's commitment to strengthening the relationship between our two countries.

Last year, we celebrated 60 years of diplomatic relations between the two countries and in January 2024, Uganda hosted a delegation from China at the 19th Non-Aligned Movement and G-77 + China during which President Museveni expressed profound gratitude to China for its unwavering support during the anti-colonial struggle and its crucial role in bolstering Africa's economic development If I may quote;

"We have been together in the anti-colonial struggle, China supported us when we were fighting for independence, it also supported the freedom fighting groups in Southern Africa; Mozambique, Zimbabwe and South Africa. China started supporting Africa economically even when the economy of China was still small. Since then, China has grown economically; it has helped Africa even more."

Nothing signifies growth like the country that you have long supported now being in a position to establish a permanent presence in China that will be home to Uganda's Chancery and Official residence, and the reason why we are here today - to lay the foundation for this important milestone and a symbol of the next phase of our journey together.



With our permanent home underway we look forward to a journey of partnership in which we put emphasis on market access because this is the best way to support one another because "If you are support what I produce, you are supporting my prosperity and when I buy what you produce, I am supporting your prosperity".

To support this collaboration, China has granted zero tariffs on 98% of taxable items from Uganda – a policy I encourage people from all over Uganda to take advantage of. On our part, we are advanced in the process of launching our National Airline – Uganda Airlines with direct flights between Entebbe and Guangzhou which will facilitate trade, business travel and tourism between our two countries. I hope to see you and many others on this flight. I wish to express my sincere thanks to those who have directly and indirectly supported the Consulate to get us this far;

In a special way, I wish to extend our deepest thanks to the following:

- Hon. Norah who has been very instrumental in making sure that the consulate gets the required budget allocation for this project in her capacity as the Chairperson for the Foreign Affairs Committee of the Uganda Parliament;
- The Foreign Affairs Office of Guangzhou for supporting our efforts in identifying and proposing potential contractors;
- · Hengsheng Construction Group Co. Ltd for accepting to take on this project as our main contractor;



This is the part where the name of a piece (always an African name) is described in terms of its origin, its choice rationale, how it blends into the XaferWear vision, and also what it is meant to represent for those who choose to wear it. It is the part where the XaferWear slogan, "Dress to make a statement!" comes into fruition. 
